BACKGROUND

NorthBay is seeking Adventure Facilitators to run the adventure activities/elements on campus. Adventure Facilitators assure the constant safety and overall supervision of students or guests attending NorthBay, ensuring a fun, safe, positive experience for all guests. School-year hours are typically 9am -6pm for staff over the age of 18, and 3pm – 6pm during weekdays, 1 – 5pm on Saturdays with occasional nights or Sunday afternoons based on guest group requests for staff under the age of 18.

NorthBay is looking for a highly motivated, personable individual with excellent communication skills and attention to detail. The successful candidate will be a motivated self-starter who can work independently and effectively within a team. The candidate will maintain a positive, friendly and professional attitude and demeanor for all students, guests and staff on campus.

- Ensure a safe and fun atmosphere for kids.
- Run assigned activities in a safe manner, including but not limited to: Indoor/Outdoor Rock Climbing Wall, Zip Lines, Waterfront, Gym, and Ropes Course.
- Assist with needs as emergencies arise. Specific roles as assigned to you.
- Attend daily meeting to make sure everyone is on point and ready to go.
- Attend regular trainings and retraining.
- Act in a courteous, professional manner at all times.
- When elements are not running, assist in maintenance and upkeep of NorthBay facilities ie: yardwork, light carpentry and custodial assistance.
